The ROHC will promote good will and cooperation between itself and other government agencies such as TANF and Social Security through the sharing of information and documentation provided by common participants.
$Throughou \ treach strategies, landlords in many communities will be encouraged to join the efforts of the ROHC; thus eliminating restrictions to or confinement of Section 8 tenant to particular areas.\\$
The ROHC will keep its payment standards at 100% of the FMR with possible increases for reasonable accommodation to qualifying families. This will enable tenant storent units otherwise unaffordable throughout the Royal Oak jurisdiction and expand the range of quality housing choices available to participants of the tenant based Section 8 program.
