



AlthoughthePHAisidentifiedwithaminimumFSSparticipantlevelof125,the PHAdoesnotnowhaveandneverhassuccessfullyimplementedtheF SSprogram.When theFSSrequirementwasinitiatedandinsubsequentyears,thePHAsubmittedmultiple applicationsforspecialDHUDfundingtosupportthisprogrambutthePHA'srequests forassistancehavebeendenied.AscitedbythePHAinpriorcorre spondencetoDHUD, thePHAdoesnothavethefinancialresourcestosupportadditionalstaffthatcanbe dedicatedtoimplementationandoperationoftheFSSProgram.

SummaryofProgressToward5 -YearPlan

ThePHA'sstatedmissionandgo alsarebasicandfundamentalconsiderationsfor compliancewiththeintentandregulationsgoverningtheSection8Housingassistance program.Fundingconstraintsandtheresultinglimitationsthisplacesonstaffinglevels, makeitimpossibleforthePH Atodomuchmorethanstriveforcompliancewithinits basicoperation.AllofthePHA'seffortsareconsistentwiththemissionofpromoting adequateandaffordablehousing,economicopportunityandasuitable,discrimination freeenvironment.

While it is believed that progress has been made toward the stated 5 -year Plan mission and goals, no concrete means of measuring this success is readily possible. The fact that the efforts continue is evidence to some degree that progress is being made. The PHA's goals are on -going is sues that can never be fully achieved. The PHA will always attempt to obtain additional funding/unitallocations, solong as the demand for assistance exceeds the supply. Likewise, the PHA will always strive tomanage its programs more efficiently and effectively, while attempting to attract more property owners to participate in the program.
