#### MCHAProgressinMeetingthe5 -YearPlan MissionandGoals

MarionCountyHousingAuthorityisworkingtowardachieving ourmissionofprovidingabetter placetoliveforcitizensofMarionCountybydeveloping,administering,andmaintaining,safe, decentandaffordablehousing.

MCHA has made excellent progress toward meeting our goals including but not limited to modernizing our current Public Housing stock, disposing of obsolete Public Housing, providing replacement housing and promoting self sufficiency and opportunity while conducting outreach toassist inhousing choices.

Progress has been made in maintaining our ho using stock by replacing obsolete and worn appliances, furnishings, and equipment. Major systems have been updated as needed, including plumbing, electrical and heating.

Theagencyhascompletedthepurchaseof8newunitsthroughOregonHousingand Community Services, the HUDRisk Sharing Program and replacement reserve funds. MCHA is also in the process of planning for the disposition of 3 units of Public Housing, which no longer meet the intent of neither our mission statement nor the budgetary constraints for low-income public housing. MCHA expects to be gintheap plication process in the spring of 2002.

MCHA has been awarded additional Vouchers to meet the growing need for affordable housing in Marion County. The agency has partnered with the Community Action Agency, Salud De La Famila and the local/district TANF agencies to improve assistance to our mutual clients and improve our community service programs.

Marion County Housing is working with local and state housing agencies to utilize all a resources for the development of new or existing affordable housing units. MCHA has added 86 units of multifamily housing units in the past year. The mixed source of funding included Revenue Bonds and Low Rent Public Housing Replacement funds. This project called Creekside Parkisserving one of our most rural areas in Aumsville, Oregon.
