Acoregroup of individuals remains motivated to provide adequatehousingforallsegmentsofthepopulationwithproper planning.Manyaspectshavebeenexploredtoutilizemixedfinanced housing.Effortsarefocusingon constructionofsinglefamily dwellingsandduplexesutilizingfundsfromtheWisconsin PartnershipforHousingDevelopment.Thecountyisexperiencing rapidgrowthalongwithotherareasofWesternWisconsin.Wehope tolearnfromthemistakesofothers &cooperativelyplan infrastructures, utilize and upgrade existing housing stock. We also helpaddressspecificneedsofmilitaryfamiliesuniquetothearea.

Theauthority will assume management of a 16 unit Family ProjectthroughUSDA -RuralDevelopment .Ifthemanagementisnot transferredtheUSDAsupportand16vouchersmaybeenremoved fromMonroeCounty.AcquisitionisscheduledforMarch1,2002.

Weplantomaximizethenumberofaffordableunitsavailable bysupportingtheconstructionofonebe droomunitsandlargerthree and four bedroom units. This would also be achieved by upgrading existinghousingstockandstrengtheningneighborhoods.

Utilization of Housing Choice Voucher funds has stabilized thefinancial status of the program that has beenoperatingtenuouslyin the pastyears. This authority has achieved 95% utilization.

#### **C.StrategyforAddressingNeeds**

ProvideabriefdescriptionofthePHA'ss trategyforaddressingthehousingneedsoffamiliesinthe jurisdictionandonthewaitinglist **INTHEUPCOMINGYEAR**, and the Agency's reasons for choosing this strategy.

The Housing Choice Voucher Program has reached 95% utilization, however, with turn over each month and the impact just one person has on the utilization percentage, there is no waiting list for the program. As individuals submit applications each month, orientation is held and the number that begin participation normally equal those leaving the program. It is anticipated a wait list will be implemented so on to maintain a 75% rate of Extremely Low Income participants.
