This Document is the 2003 update with the Management Action Planforthe Fiscal year ending 9/30/04. The regulations promulgated by the U.S Dept. of Housing and Urban Development mandate the following:

The Authority assembled a Resident Advisory Board of nine (9) members who have metand developed the plan covering all items contained in the Document. This Agency Plan covers the Public Housing and the Section 8 Housing Assistance Programs, both offered by the City of Hornell Housing Authority.

The Planthe City of Hornell Housing Authority established in cludes a Mission Statement and four (4) goals for the five years 2000 through 2004.

The Mission Statement reads:

"The City of Hornell Housing Authority wi Ilprovide Housing Choicestopeople of all backgrounds, through social, educational and financial opportunities that will allow all families and individuals a secure, positive, who leso meands elf supporting way of life."

Thefour(4)goalsareasfollows:

- increasing the availability of decent, safe and affordable housing,
- improving the quality of life and economic vitality of the community
- promotingself -sufficiencyandassetdevelopmentoffamiliesandindividuals
- increasinghomeownershipintheHornel lCommunity

The Planindicates that there is not a need for the Authority to increase the number of owned housing units, as our waiting lists are manageable with our present assets. However, the requests for Section 8 rental assistance cannot be met. Therefore the Authority will look to increase the number of rental vouchers available.

The Authority will change its preferences, adopted in July 2000, for admission giving preference to homeless individuals from the City of Hornell, then to the immediate a rea. No preference will be given

tothehomelessfromzipcodeareasthatarenotspecificallystatedinthePolicy.TheAuthorityhas addedpolicyprovisionsforde -concentrationofincomewithincomplexesandselectionprovisionsto allowtheAuthoritytomeettheincometargetingrequiredbytheQHWRAlegislation.Inaddition,the PlanindicatesrentalchargesforitsprogramsthatincludesCeilingandFlatRentsandthetraditional30% ofIncomecalculationforPublicHousingandestablishmentofPay mentStandardsfortheSec.8HAP program.

FinancialResourceslistsexpectedincomefromallsourcestobe\$1,463,243withexpendituresequaling income.ThePlanlistscapitalimprovementexpensesat\$245,234andwillincludeSiteimprovementsat ChurchSt.Court,SawyersSt.SiteandtheClusteredHousingUnits.

The Housing Authority has no plans for demolition or disposition of its units, nor down anticipate any conversion of our public housing units to private sector units supported by Section 8 Vouc her Assistance.
