The following adult members are exempt from this requirement: Family members who are 62 or older, family members who are blind or disabled, family members who are primary caregiver for someone who is blind or disabled, family members engaged in work activity, family members who are exempt from work activity under Part A title IV of the Social Security Act or under any other state welfare program, including the welfare to work program, family members receiving assistance under a state program funded under Part A title IV of the Social Security Act or under any other state welfare program, including welfare to work and who are in compliance with that program.
