Attachment A to the Annual Plan Freehold Housing Authority "FHA" FYE 12/31/2007

In accordance with PIH Notice 2006-23 "Implementation of the Violence Against Women and Justice Department Reauthorization Act 2005" PHA's are required to state their goals and objectives as they relate to Public Law 109-162. The FHA has taken the following steps in order to implement the Law:

- 1) The FHA does not presently provide a preference for tenant selection to its public housing program for victims of domestic violence. The FHA will discuss this matter with its Board of Commissioners and review its admissions and occupancy policy to determine if this preference should be included.
- 2) In case of an action to evict from public housing domestic violence will be used as a mitigating factor in consideration to pursue the action.
- 3) The FHA will not discriminate against victims of domestic violence in tenant selection decisions for its public housing program.
- 4) The present policies of the FHA do not prohibit or limit a resident's right to summon police or other emergency assistance in response to domestic violence.
- 5) The FHA is ready to assist victims of domestic violence with referrals to appropriate agencies.
- 6) The admissions and occupancy policy of the FHA will be amended to reflect the above.
