Housing Needs. Based on information provided by the applicable Consolidated Plan, information provided by HUD, and other generally available data, make a reasonable effort to identify the housing needs of the low-income, very low-income, and extremely low-income families who reside in the jurisdiction served by the PHA, including elderly families, families with disabilities, and households of various races and ethnic groups, and other families who are on the public housing and Section 8 tenant-based assistance waiting lists. There are currently 134 Applicants on the active waiting list for public housing. Of these applicants, 2 % (or 3 applicants) are low-income, 10% (or 13 applicants) are very low-income and 88% (or 118 applicants) are extremely low-income. 28% (or 37 applicants) are elderly families and 30% (or 40 applicants) are disabled families. 53% (or 71 applicants) are white, 21% (or 28 applicants) are black, 22% (or 30 applicants) are Hispanic and 4% (or 5 applicants) are Indian.

Strategy for Addressing Housing Needs. Provide a brief description of the PHA's strategy for addressing the housing needs of families in the jurisdiction and on the waiting list in the upcoming year. Due to funding and staff constraints, the PHA has selected the following strategies to address housing needs: Maximize the number of affordable units available to the PHA within its current resources by employing effective maintenance and management policies to minimize the number of public housing units off-line and reduce turnover time for vacated public housing units. Increase the number of affordable housing units by applying for additional section 8 units should they become available. Adopt rent policies to support and encourage work and employ admissions preferences aimed at families who are working.

Additional Information. Describe the following, as well as any additional information HUD has requested.

(a) Progress in Meeting Mission and Goals. Provide a brief statement of the PHA's progress in meeting the mission and goals described in the 5- Year Plan.

The Housing Authority of the City of Bastrop was awarded Low Income Housing Tax Credits to build a 66-unit senior housing development. However, due to the down turn in the economy, there were too many risk factors that were out of our control to allow us to proceed with the development. These risk factors included (i) uncertainty about the amount of credits that would be available, (ii) investor and lender appetite for projects in rural communities, (iii) tax credit pricing in the mid-60's, (iv) uncertainty about the tax exemption required to make the deal work and (v) a land seller that was not willing to wait for a closing until we could resolve some of the uncertainties. The Housing Authority has renovated public housing units and continued with the modernization plan.

The Housing Authority has assisted five non-resident low to moderate income families with down payment assistance through the FHLB of Dallas Homebuyer Equity Leverage Partnership (HELP) Program. The Housing Authority has collaborated with the USDA's Rural Development program to assist clients with homeownership and continues to work with one disabled Section 8 participant to purchase a home using a combination of these programs. While the participant has been qualified, the participant has not been able to close on a home due to the decrease in market values and appraisal values.

Housing Authority of the City of Bastrop 2009 Agency Plan Resident Advisory Board Comments

The Resident Advisory Board (RAB) met on <u>June 9, 2009</u> where the 2009 Agency Plan was discussed. The concerns addressed by the RAB were primarily related to physical improvements of dwelling units.
